RECYCLABLE PAPER

- Newspapers and Inserts
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Junk Mail and Envelopes
- Home Office Paper

THESE PAPERS GO IN YOUR GARBAGE:

- Wet, soiled or food-stained paper
- Paper Towels, facial or toilet tissue
- Disposable plates and cups
- Dark-colored envelopes and folders
Cards
- Boxboard (cereal boxes, shoe boxes, soda cartons, etc.)
- Pizza Boxes
- Phone Books
- Wrapping Paper
 - Holiday & Greeting

RECYCLING ALUMINUM

Most aluminum cans are labeled. If you are not sure whether it is aluminum or not, test it with a magnet. Aluminum is not magnetic. Be sure to rinse the cans before putting them in the bin.

RECYCLING PLASTIC

Check these three items:

1. **Shape:** Only plastic bottles can be recycled. (No tubs, jars, bag or tray)
2. **Type:** Check the number on the bottom of the bottle. Only #1 or #2 can be recycled.
3. **Contents:** If the bottle contained motor oil, bug spray, weed killer, adhesives, paints or solvents, it *cannot* be recycled no matter what type of plastic it was made from.

EXAMPLES OF RECYCLABLE PLASTIC

- Water, soda and juice bottles
- Milk jugs
- Shampoo, conditioner & liquid soap bottles
- Detergent bottles
- Bleach and all-purpose cleaner bottles

THESE PLASTICS GO IN YOUR GARBAGE:

- Yogurt & Margarine Tub
- Plastic bags & packaging
- Disposable plates, cups & utensils
- Microwave Trays
- Containers used to hold bakery products, produce and take-out food
- Styrofoam
- Toys
- Motor Oil Bottles
- Lids
